- Makes laws
- Participates in debate
- Scrutinizes the government
- Brings ideas for laws to parliament
- Considers bills in select communities
- Represents the people in their constituency
- Consults their constituency and interest groups regularly
- Brings the constituency's concerns and issues to the Parliament and the government
- Participates in political negotiations if no party has outright majority to form the government
- Participates in parliamentary processes for the development and approval of the national budget
