Organic Law on National and Local-level Government Elections

APPOINTMENT OF RETURNING OFFICERS

THE ELECTORAL COMMISSION, by virtue of the powers conferred by Sections 18 (Delegation) and 19 (Returning Officers) of the Organic Law on National and Local-level Government Elections ("Electoral Law"), hereby delegates the specific powers and functions listed below and appoints the persons listed in the Schedule to be the Returning Officers during the candidate nomination, polling, and scrutiny periods for the Electorate opposite their names during the 2022 National Election. Their appointments are set from 30th April until 31st August 2022.

I. DELEGATION OF POWERS AND FUNCTIONS

Upon acceptance of their appointment, the Returning Officers shall ensure that the conduct of candidate nomination, polling, and scrutiny in their assigned Electorate are performed in accordance with the provisions of the Electoral Law and the Electoral Law (National Elections) Regulation 2007 ("Electoral Regulations") and under the direction of the Electoral Commission. The Returning Officers shall abide by the Papua New Guinea Electoral Commission (PNGEC) Code of Conduct for electoral officials.

During the appointment period, Returning Officers shall resolve election-related disputes that may be referred to them during the course of nomination, campaign, polling, and scrutiny in accordance with Electoral Law and Electoral Regulations. They shall also complete and submit all electoral forms to the Electoral Commission within the period specified by the applicable law and regulations.

The Returning Officers shall exercise the following powers and functions:

A. Candidate Nomination

- 1. Attend at the place of nomination for the electorate; publicly produce all nomination papers and electronic advices of nominations received; accept duly qualified candidates for nomination based on the criteria provided by the laws and regulations; and declare the names, addresses, and occupations of all candidates nominated.
- Refer in writing to the Electoral Commissioner for acceptance or rejection of the nomination of any
 intending candidate who is objected to in writing by anyone; and any intending candidate for whom the
 Returning Officer believes on reasonable grounds is not qualified to nominate under the applicable
 laws.

- Place the name of the accepted candidate on the Ward Electoral Roll for the Electorate being nominated for,
 if that person is not enrolled for that electorate and such person is duly qualified to nominate.
- 4. Accept the withdrawal of the nomination of any candidates who submit the prescribed form prior to the end of the nomination period.
- 5. At the end of the nomination period, declare a candidate duly elected if he or she is the only candidate nominated for the Electorate, and where more than one candidate has been nominated for an Electorate, conduct and announce the candidate draw.

B. Polling

- 1. Prepare, publicize, and implement in a timely manner a polling schedule for the assigned Electorate showing the anticipated dates and times within the polling period in accordance with directions from the Electoral Commission.
- 2. Engage and supervise Presiding Officers, Assistant Presiding Officers, Poll Clerks, Queue Controllers, Ballot Box Guards, and other polling officials.
- 3. Before the start of polling, ensure that polling booths are set up and furnished with necessary polling equipment and materials, including candidate posters, ballot papers, and the certified list of voters.
- 4. During polling, resolve all election-related disputes brought to his or her attention by Presiding Officers.
- 5. At the end of polling, ensure the integrity of ballot boxes, presiding officer journals, certified lists of voters, and other election documents used in polling, and transport the same for scrutiny at the designated count centers.

C. Scrutiny and Count

- 1. Appoint the place for scrutiny and count and officers to assist in scrutiny and counting.
- 2. Supervise and conduct the scrutiny and count process in the assigned Electorate.
- 3. Verify and sign the requisite scrutiny and count forms and deliver the same to the Electoral Commission.
- 4. At the end of scrutiny and count process, with the express concurrence of the Electoral Commission, declare the result of the election and ensure the winning candidate signs the writ.
- 5. Return the signed writ to the Electoral Commissioner.

II. LIMITATIONS TO THE POWERS OF RETURNING OFFICERS

The Electoral Commission specifically prohibits the Returning Officers from exercising the following powers and functions.

Returning Officers shall not enter into any financial contract or commitment for goods and/or services in the name of the PNGEC, without the express written permission of the Electoral Commission or his duly designated representative.

Furthermore, the Returning Officers shall not:

- A. Deviate from the procedures specified by the Constitution, Electoral Law, Electoral Regulations, and directives from the Electoral Commission;
- B. Reject any nomination based on formal defect or error, if they are satisfied that the provisions of the Constitution, Electoral Law, and Electoral Regulations have been substantially complied with;
- C. Accept the nomination of any person who submitted his or her nomination after the end of the nomination period as specified in the Electoral Law;
- D. Change the polling date unless so directed by the Electoral Commissioner;
- E. Set aside any ward ballot boxes for dispute during the conduct of the scrutiny and count process within the desingated Electorate counting center unless a candidate or scrutineer lodges a written objection with a statutory declaration of the facts for review by the Electoral Commission in line with the applicable laws and regulations; and
- F. Declare a winning candidate without the written concurrence of the Electoral Commissioner or his appointed delegate.

III. RETENTION OF POWERS AND FUNCTIONS

The Electoral Commission retains the sole power to reject an intending candidate's nomination, based on evidence of that person's disqualification under the applicable laws.

Furthermore, the Electoral Commission retains the power to declare a winning Electorate candidate upon the conclusion of the scrutiny and count process based upon the report by the Returning Officer.

The Electoral Commission reserves the right to revise or expand the delegation and/or retention of the powers and functions noted above with due notice under the applicable laws.

IV. APPOINTMENT OF PROVINCIAL RETURNING OFFICERS
